Meeting Minutes – March 25, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M. on Monday March 25, 2013 at the Star Prairie Community Center.

The Treasurers report was given by Nelson. Current bank account balances total \$87,875.27 as of March 1, 2013. Motion by Wood to approve the Treasurers report, seconded by Davison, motion carried.

Lake Resident Survey.

· Early reported the survey of lake residents had been mailed out. Roughly 46% have been returned to date, with another week to go before the deadline stated in the survey.

Lake Plan Discussion.

· An Advisory Committee for the purpose of input for Lake Plan contents and concerns has been formed and is scheduled to meet 4 times before mid-summer. The committee will consist of various volunteers familiar with Cedar Lake issues and its importance to the area. Nelson reported the DNR Small Lake Planning Grant request was approved for Cedar Lake. The grant was \$2,680 with the lake association providing \$1,320 for a total grant value of \$4,000.

· Davison reported that Dan Michaelis, the current website provider is interested in cutting back on the websites he hosts and designs. Davison has researched various options and suggested JJ Web Services from Balsam Lake. JJ Web Services will also be designing and hosting the websites for Star Prairie Fish and Game and the Star Prairie Land Preservation Trust. A motion was made by Wood and seconded by Nelson to authorize Dan Davison to enter into an agreement on behalf of the Association with JJ Web Services for the re-design of our website, website maintenance and web hosting. Motion carried.
