 \cdot Invasive Species. Reckinger reported we received three grant reimbursements last week. 2 of these were for Clean Boats – Clean Waters and one for alum treatment monitoring. He is working with Cheryl on the required permits for chemical and DASH milfoil treatments for 2019.

 \cdot Parcel Detachment. Ron Siler has prepared the final papers which have to be signed by Demulling and Davison. This should be completed next week.

 \cdot Lakeshore Zoning and Regulations Discussion. Wood is getting the appropriate St. Croix county contact information for our flyer.

 \cdot Keyhole Ordinance. Wood confirmed that although a keyhole ordinance was discussed and even drafted in the past, it was never recorded or put into effect. He will do some more checking and report back at a future meeting.
